

CORFA Strike Duty Information

In order to receive strike pay, College of the Rockies Faculty Association members need to perform four (4) hours of picket duty in accordance with CORFA's Job Action Policy. A sign-up sheet is posted on the CORFA office door for faculty picketing the Cranbrook campus.

Cranbrook and Gold Creek Campuses

Picket duty begins at 6:00 a.m. and ends at 10:00 p.m. The shifts are as follows:

Golden, Fernie, Creston Campuses

Kimberley Campuses

To receive strike pay, faculty who work primarily at the Kimberley campus are required to complete the four-hour picket duty shifts at the Cranbrook campus.

Invermere Campuses

To receive strike pay, faculty who work primarily at the Invermere campus are required to complete the four-hour picket duty shifts at the Golden or Cranbrook campus. CORFA will reimburse the cost of travel to the driver of the vehicle in accordance with the CORFA's travel policy. Faculty Association members are encouraged to travel together.

Picketing Etiquette

Although CORFA prefers members do not cross picket lines; if that situation occurs, CORFA members are to move out of the way. Law requires picketers to keep moving. Please be safe on the picket lines. Do not disrupt the flow of traffic.

Strike Pay

As per the CORFA Job Action Policy, CORFA members of the Association who fulfill picket duties receive strike pay at the rate of \$100.00 per day per member to a maximum of \$500.00 per week, while funds are available.
